GAA NSW Constitution Requirements for nomination to Committee

31.3 Elected Committee Members

- (a) An Elected Committee Member must be a natural person who is a Member, or a Representative and has paid any annual Subscriptions which are due.
- (b) Nominations of candidates for election as Elected Committee Members:
 - (i) shall be in writing in a form prescribed by the Committee signed by two (2) Members and be accompanied by the written consent of the nominee (which may be endorsed on the nomination), including a statement as to whether the nominee is also nominating for the position of President; and
 - (ii) shall be delivered to the Secretary (or other person authorised by the Committee for the purpose) not later than close of business two (2) Business Days before the day fixed for the holding of the AGM at which the election is to take place.
